

**A**N example of the use of dropcap macro with Keith's and Werner's patches applied. However as noted by Keith it fails when the user specifies vertical space during a drop capital. For example

**W**HEN appropriate adjustment parameters are specified, it produces a rather nice effect, as we can see the subsequent lines indented by -1n each line down the drop capital. It is possible to append more parameters to this macro, each parameter indicates the relative indentation for the next line. Therefore it is possible to make text pull in and out of a drop capital I.
